



ARBITRATION COURT

and Agricultural Chamber of the Czech Republic

Directive of the Secretary of the Arbitration Court attached to the Czech Chamber of Commerce and the Czech Agrarian Chamber related to the requirements on arbitrators.

1. This directive is obligatory for all applicants applying for inclusion in the list of arbitrators of the **Arbitration Court attached to the Czech Chamber of Commerce and the Czech Agrarian Chamber** (hereinafter referred to as “Czech Arbitration Court”).
2. The applicant applying for inclusion must meet the following criteria:
 - a) Minimum age of 30 years.
 - b) Master’s degree (or a degree equal to second-cycle or graduate degree)
 - c) The applicant must show adequate knowledge and experience including knowledge of law and jurisprudence, as well as personal conduct that will guarantee trustworthy performance of arbitrator’s duties.
3. The applicant applying for an inclusion and who meets the criteria laid down in point 2. must:
 - a) Fill in the application form and send it to e-mail address prague@arbcourt.cz or to the postal address of the Czech Arbitration Court. The form can be downloaded on the website of the Czech Arbitration Court (<http://en.soud.cz/download>).
 - b) Include an up-to-date criminal records disclosure.
4. Czech Arbitration Court reserves the right to set down further requirements for inclusion on its lists of arbitrators for special kinds of proceedings. The further requirements might comprise of written examinations, personal interviews and attending expert seminars.
5. Czech Arbitration Court reserves the right to set down further requirements on the arbitrators already included on its lists, for example personal interviews or attending expert seminars.
6. According to the Art. IV par. (1) of the Statutes of the Czech Arbitration Court, the board of the Czech Arbitration Court decides on including new arbitrators on the list or striking off arbitrators of the list.
